**“Dålig sikt och regn” (Poor visibility and rain)**

Parti & minut releases their second album! Four years have passed since the critic's acclaimed and Swedish indie-Grammy-nominated debut "Från klart till halvklart (From clear to semi-cloudy)" Now comes the eagerly anticipated follow up, "Dålig sikt och regn (Poor visibility and rain." Much has happened since the last album, but the trumpet-tuba-drums trio's unique blend of free jazz, children's music and general funkiness is the same, but here further streamlined and refined.

Including and welcoming are key words when the three strong individuals form a unit. Seemingly scattered and variegated

expressions are intermingled when they play together and form a much stronger whole. This is the key to the band's distinctive and imaginative musical universe.

The band consists of:

- Johan Norin - trumpet, born and raised on the Swedish west coast. Playing with Ska/Reggae band, Club Killers and behind artists like Amanda Jensen and Miss Li.
- Per-Åke Holmlander, tuba. Born and raised in the north. World Renowned tubaist and improviser who has played with "everyone" on the Swedish and international free scene during the past twenty years, including Peter Brotzman, Mats Gustafsson, Barry Guy.
- Christopher Cantillo – drums, born and raised in Gothenburg. He's a restless and cordial drummer with an extensive discography and track record at a relatively early age. Heard otherwise with Nils Berg's "Cinemascope", Jonas Östholm quartet, Mattias Ståhl and many more.
